


# My Trams Timeline


Join to 1910s >

Create a timeline of significant trams events. 1. Cut this sheet into two pieces along the dotted line. 2. Join the two pieces together to make one long strip. 3. Above the tram track, draw or write about an object in each decade, for example a tram, an advert, street furniture, or another object on display.
