

Tram Weekend Timetable

Saturday 14th September 2024



All timings are approximate. The programme may need to be altered on the day due to the weather, availability of trams and the availability of staff.

As we celebrate 60 years of electric tram operation at Crich, we also look forward to the future with a focus on our recent restoration projects.

Our investment for the future means that we are currently part way through a project to upgrade our electricity supply. As a result, we are currently operating on a temporary supply, which limits the number of trams we can operate at any one time.

1000	Curtain Raiser: Capital Trams Our latest full restoration project, LCC No. 1, will feature in a London tram display in the street.
1030	Tram Service Commences with LCC1 operating the first departure
1030 to 1200	Intensive Tram Service in operation, with multiple trams departing every 10 minutes
1030 to 1230	Shunting on the Depot Fan as trams are brought out for display, including the opportunity to see our traverser in use with trams moving sideways!
1030 to 1600	Exhibition Hall Displays: Electric 60; Sporting Stories from Tramway History; collection curiosities.
1100 to 1200	Depot Fan Display A display of trams in our collection on the Depot Fan.
1200 to 1400	Some trams return to Depot for Lunch, with Photographic Opportunities on the Depot Fan
1200 to 1400	Tutbury Band playing on the Bandstand
1400 to 1700	Intensive Tram Service in operation, with multiple trams departing every 10 minutes
1500 to 1600	Depot Fan Display A display of trams in our collection on the Depot Fan, celebrating 60 years of Electric Tram Operation at Crich.
1630	Shunting on the Depot Fan to put all the trams away!
1700	Last Trams

Service Trams (Subject to Availability):

All available trams will operate on at least one day over the weekend. The expected trams for this day are: LCC 1, Chesterfield 7, Glasgow 22, Sheffield 74, Newcastle 102, LCC 106, Blackpool 166, Blackpool 167, Oporto 273, Sheffield 510, Liverpool 869, LPTB 1622.
